

BuildingEnergyTechnologies focusses on the Hannover Fair in Hall 27

From integrated planning over resources-saving construction to efficient operation for non-residential buildings - from Monday 1st April until Friday 5th April 2019 the Hannover Fair concentrates exhibitors and visitors to "BuildingEnergyTechnologies - BET" in Hall 27, already for the second time. Manufacturers will show systems and components of higher power as well as service providers technically sophisticated, often individual solutions for energy-efficient buildings. Instead of thinking in crafts, integrated planning is in demand among the predominantly small and medium-sized exhibitors. This results in a variety of often equivalent technical approaches, the parts of which are comprehensively covered here by manufacturers and contractors of building services.



Both focal points of the exhibition are, on the one hand, services provided by architects, planners, energy consultants/auditors, facility managers, financiers and energy traders, and, on the other hand, power, heat, refrigeration, craft-spanning systems and components. Planners, architects and engineers of all disciplines but also investors, project developers and building owners as well as operators and users of buildings will benefit from a visit. Especially energy managers, energy consultants, energy auditors and facility managers, custodians, building technicians meet new contacts. The Speakers's Forum "BuildingEnergyTechnologies" contributes up-to-date information in lectures and podium discussions, in direct neighbourhood to the special exhibition "Decentralized Energy Supply".

The successful start of 2018 showed in the high number of 255 exhibitors with nearly 600 products around the building, mainly in Halls 27, 12 and 13. They came from over 20 countries with a focus on China, Germany, Italy, Turkey, including well-known names as well as start-ups with innovative approaches such as Synavision. 2019 are i.e. already registered: bioclimatic, ELWA, REMKO, Schwank and Zumtobel Lighting.
